BIBS and UNIFORM


 BIBS TO BE WORN AS ISSUED AND NOT DEFACED – DISQUALIFICATION

 A UNIFORM (VEST) MUST BE WORN CLEARLY IDENTIFYING THE COUNTRY REPRESENTED









NATURAL TEAMS

The classification will be defined by the sum of the times of the first three athletes of each country, provided that they are integrated in the same age group.

If there are three or more athletes within the same age group, team registration is not necessary, being the team automatically constituted by the top three athletes classified.

SUGGESTION

Registration is necessary if one or more athlete from one category make composed team in other category with events started at the same time.





COMPOSED TEAMS

If the team is made up of three athletes of different age groups, but who compete at the same time in the same race, the team will be ranked in the lowest age athlete category.

In this situation it is mandatory to register the team.

If an athlete from an older age group will be registered to the composed team and event taking off at a different time of his category, he/she will not be individually classified in the appropriate age groups for themselves.

The list of participants in the competition will be released before the start of the competition.

<u>ATION</u>

- <u>ASSISTANCE</u> THIS IS A WARNING TO YOUR ATHLETES, ASSISTANCE IN THE COMPETITION AREA — DISQUALIFICATION
- ATHLETES CAN BE <u>DISQUALIFIED</u> DURING OR AFTER THE RACE.
- THE WA PIT LANE WILL NOT BE USED.

REFRESHMENT

- <u>PERSONAL REFRESHMENTS</u> MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH THEIR BIB NUMBER and WILL BE AVAILABLE ON THE TABLE ASSIGNED TO PERSONAL REFRESHMENTS.
- A MAXIMUM OF <u>TWO OFFICIALS PER COUNTRY</u> MAY BE STATIONED AT EACH TABLE TO MANAGE THE REFRESHMENTS OF THEIR ATHLETES. COUNTRY REPRESENTATIVES MUST NOT INTERFERE WITH THE RACE PROGRESS.
- NO REFRESHMENTS TO BE ISSUED OUTSIDE THE REFRESHMENT ZONE.
- AN ATHLETE RECEIVING REFRESHMENT FROM A PLACE OTHER THAN THE OFFICIAL STATIONS OR ANOTHER ATHLETE, FOR THE FIRST OFFENCE BE WARNED (YELLOW CARD) BY THE REFEREE, THE SECOND OFFENCE RED CARD AND DISQUALIFICATION.





CHIP COLLECTION, CALL ROOM

CHIP COLLECTION – TO BE PICKED UP FROM 1 HOURS – 30 MINUTES BEFORE THE START OF EACH RACE BEFORE THE CALL ROOM.

DO NOT WAIT UN TILL THE LAST MINUTE.

CHIPS TO BE RETURNED TO VOLUNTEERS AT THE END OF EACH RACE – 10 EUROS PENALTY.





APPEALS

<u>APPEALS</u> MUST BE MADE NO LATER THAN ONE HOUR AFTER THE DISPLAY OF RESULTS.

PROTEST TO THE REFEREE FIRST.

<u>INDIVIDUAL MEDALS</u>

ATHLETES WHO JOIN AN AGE GROUP TEAM HAVE THE RIGHT TO AN INDIVIDUAL MEDAL IF THEIR OWN CATEGORY ARE IN THE SAME RACE AS THEIR COMPOSITE TEAM
